

Group 23 // Harpurhey Redevelopment

Harpurhey has no lack of community presence, but this areas focus is oriented towards an older demographic. Our proposal focuses on adaptive re-use, introducing additive design that creates potential for recreation whilst keeping the town centre recognizable to its residents. Lightweight and versatile. Mobile lanterns line the walkway, creating intimate spaces within the communal square. When raised, it opens up space, encouraging social interaction. Whilst down, it creates an intimate gathering space for events. Usable space has been extended vertically, and a large platform now spans across the pitched roofs. This space is reserved for pop up stores, food stalls and recreational spaces to attract a younger demographic. The addition of a playful slide with bright cladding around the tower acts as a beacon to entice people to the area.
