IDENTITY TOOLKIT



WORDMARK



This is the standard wordmark to be used on all communications and marketing.

The standard wordmark can also be used in white when used on a dark background.

The wordmark is stacked so 'school' protrudes as a cantilever, a nod to architectural forms and the built environment.

The space below the cantilever in the identity is the basis of the brand grid and this space dictates the size of other brand elements.

Please leave clear space around the logo. As a minimum, the spacing should be at least the same height as the 'cantilever space' on all four sides of the logo.

The minimum size for the identity is 30mm wide in print and 120px wide on screen.

On MSA branded communications, the MSA wordmark should always be the largest logo on the page.

WORDMARK POSITIONING

Unless the identity is to sit alongside partner logos on non-MSA branded communications (see pages 11 & 12), the logo should always sit in the top left of the artwork.

If the logo is to sit with other funders and organisations (such as MMU and UoM), it should maintain the cantilever clear space and be no smaller than 30mm wide if possible.

This only applies to non-MSA branded communications. If the artwork is MSA branded, the wordmark should sit in the top left corner (see page 10) and the supporter/partner logos should be positioned separately at the bottom of the artwork






THE MSA GRID



The MSA grid is based on the cantilever space in the identity. It is a flexible system which adapts to the size of the artwork and the size of the identity. The grid underpins every piece of artwork with a strong architectural framework.

MSA FRAMING DEVICE




The consistent positioning of the MSA wordmark and the subheading frames the content. The frame helps MSA to take ownership of the content it surrounds and allows the work within it to breathe.

HOW NOT TO USE THE FRAMING DEVICE



MSSA FRAMING DEVICE

For MSSA events, the MSA logo moves to the bottom of the poster in the 'supporter logos' and the frame changes to use the MSSA lock up in the top left.

This gives MSSA a sense of ownership over the communication while still remaining in the MSA style.

The primary MSA typeface is **Tungsten**. The typeface has its roots in modernism, with a modular style, sticking to a strict grid and set of geometric rules. Both the name and form references the built environment and architectural forms, making perfect for MSA.

As well as **Tungsten** for headlines, we use Roboto for body/ supporting text. These typefaces should be used for all official MSA communication. Roboto is open source so everyone should have access to the font. It can be downloaded from here for free: <u>https://fonts.google.com/specimen/Roboto</u>

All MSA staff should have access to **Tungsten** for school branded communications but when this is not available or for student-created artwork (MSSA communication, student exhibitions etc) **League Gothic** can be used as a open-source alternative for headings and subheadings. 

This is a good opportunity to get involved with tackling a real issue, especially if your studio project incorporates the issue of homelessness.




